SOMETIME DURING THE EVENING OF 14 FEB 2022, VANDALS DAMAGED OUR RESTORED HISTORIC MAIN ENTRY DOORS.

The Board, the Masons and a few friends spent over 240 hours restoring the doors and Invested over \$800 in supplies. The vandalism WAS DISCOVERED BY BOARD MEMBER YVONNE RATCLIFFE ON 15 FEB 2022. A POLICE REPORT HAS BEEN FILED, AND THEY ARE INVESTIGATING IT AND ANOTHER INCIDENT DOWNTOWN THE WEEK BEFORE. THE GLASS HAS BEEN TAPED FOR SAFETY AS WE WAIT FOR THE NEW GLASS TO BE INSTALLED. WE THANK THE COMMUNITY FOR ITS PATIENCE WHILE REPAIRS ARE MADE.



HISTORIC TIMELINE OF THE MASONIC CORNERSTONE BUILDING

1844 – Lodge 50 Chartered


1890s – Lodge Works towards a New home The Montgomery Lodge No. 50, Free & Accepted Masons, was chartered on May 27, 1844, almost 178 years ago. In the 1890s, five Masonic Bodies



1901–1903 Construction of the current Masonic temple

1904 – Building Dedicated

DECEMBER 2019 – CRAWFORDSVILLE MASONIC TEMPLE FOUNDATION RECEIVES THE BUILDING TO PRESERVE IT



MERGED TO FORM THE TEMPLE ASSOCIATION WITH THE DREAM OF BUILDING A REMARK-ABLE NEW LODGE BUILDING. THE MASONS WORKED FOR ALMOST A DECADE TO OBTAIN FUNDS AND A LOAN, TO BUILD THE CURRENT "CRAWFORDSVILLE

Masonic Temple".

THE CRAWFORDSVILLE JOURNAL WED, APRIL 3, 1901, P 5 NOTED THAT "THE MATTER OF ERECTING A SUITABLE HOME FOR THE MASONIC BODIES IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY HAS LONG BEEN THE DREAM OF ITS DEVOTED MEMBERS, AND THE COMMITTEE HAVING THE MATTER IN CHARGE HAS BEEN QUIETLY BUT PERSISTENTLY WORKING FOR MORE THAN ONE YEAR TO PLACE THE MATTER ON A DEFINITE BASIS..." THE LOCAL NEWSPAPER COVERED

> THE PLANNING OF THE NEW FACILITY WHICH CONSISTED OF A COMMITTEE REFINING THE PLANS UP TO 10 TIMES. THE ARTICLE GOES ON TO DESCRIBE IN DETAIL EACH ROOM AND ITS PURPOSE. "IT IS SAFE TO SAY THAT NO MASONIC HOME IN THE STATES OF THE CENTRAL WEST WILL APPROACH IT IN CONVENIENCE, COMPLETENESS OR BEAUTY..." THIS BUILDING WAS BIG NEWS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE **CRAWFORDSVILLE MASONIC TEMPLE** WAS "BUILT EXCLUSIVELY FOR SOCIAL PURPOSES". IN THE PAST THIS BUILDING WAS USED EXTENSIVELY BY THE COMMUNITY FOR BANQUETS, RECEPTIONS, PROMS AND FUNERALS. IT WAS OPEN TO SERVICE MEN ON LEAVE DURING BOTH WORLD WARS, AND THE RED CROSS ALSO USED THE LOWER FLOOR DURING THAT TIME. THE BUILDING THEATRE WAS USED FROM 1918 THROUGH THE EARLY 1960S FOR OVER 200 PRODUCTIONS BY THE CRAWFORDSVILLE DRAMATIC CLUB, WABASH COLLEGE AND CRAWFORDSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL.

SOME INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT THIS BUILDING INCLUDE:

ORIGINAL BUILDING (70'X125'X50'H) – IT IS HISTORICALLY NOTED AS A TWO-STORY BUILDING THAT HAS TEN LEVEL CHANGES.

CONSTRUCTION/FIRST BRICK LAID ON SEPTEMBER 3, 1901 – A.F. RAMSEY, BUILDING COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN CORNERSTONE WAS LAID ON OCTOBER 31, 1901, WITH GOVERNOR DURBIN OFFICIATING AND A LOT OF COMMUNITY FANFARE

The Masons expected to spend \$32,000 on building as of April 1902; however, the Property and Building was completed at the cost of \$50,000


The building was dedicated on May 27, 1904, the sixtieth anniversary of the founding of Masonry in Crawfordsville, with Lew Wallace leading the parade and ceremonies

CRAWFORDSVILLE MASONIC TEMPLE FOUNDATION, A 501(C)3 NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, WAS FORMED TO PRESERVE THE BUILDING AND HAS OWNED THE BUILDING SINCE DECEMBER 2019.

THE BOARD OF THE CRAWFORDSVILLE MASONIC TEMPLE FOUNDATION (CMTF) CONTINUES TO WORK DILIGENTLY TO RAISE FUNDS THROUGH CAPITAL CAMPAIGNS, FUNDRAISERS AND GRANT WRITING.

IN 2022, WE HAVE AN URGENT NEED TO REPAIR OUR MASONRY AND WINDOWS IN ORDER TO STOP THE WATER DAMAGE. AFTER STANDING STRONG FOR 120 YEARS, THE MORTAR BETWEEN THE BRICKS HAS DETERIORATED – AND IN SOME AREAS COMPLETELY DISAPPEARED – RESULTING IN SIGNIFICANT WATER LEAKS AND A COMPROMISED STRUC-TURE. ADDITIONALLY, ALL OF THE WINDOWS NEED TO BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED DUE TO ROTTING SILLS AND LOOSE OR BROKEN GLASS.

THE FOUNDATION'S GRANT COMMITTEE HAS IDENTIFIED **AN**

OPPORTUNITY TO RECEIVE \$100,000 FOR THESE REPAIRS IF WE CAN MATCH IT BY RAISING \$100,000 OURSELVES BY JUNE 2022.

WORKING TOGETHER, WE CAN MEET THIS CHALLENGE. WE ARE ASKING EVERY MEMBER OF LODGE 50, YORK RITE, EASTERN STAR, THE FOUNDA-TION BOARD, PRESENT AND PAST, AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO MAKE A MONETARY CONTRIBUTION TO

THE BUILDING RENOVATION FUND.

WORKING TOGETHER, WE CAN RENOVATE THIS BUILDING FOR THE WHOLE COMMUNITY.
